Breakout and Workshop Descriptions**

Sunday (SOLD OUT!)

Sunday Morning Special NA-YGN Networking Event – “Let San Francisco Captivate You!” NA-YGN conference attendees participating in the special event Sunday morning will be given the opportunity to see San Francisco and visit the famous Alcatraz State Park while networking with other conference attendees. Monday Breakout 1

Drive Change in the Workplace - Panel of members that have successfully initiated projects to issue in change.

Or

New Green Energy Technologies - Panel of individuals knowledgeable in new energy technology including Smart Grid, Plug-in Hybrids, Building Construction and Concentrated Solar. Panelists will also describe how these technologies affect nuclear and the renewable energy standards.

Monday Breakout 2

Issue in Change by Welcoming Those "New to Nuke" – Panel members will discuss best practices on orientation and integration practices of new employees into nuclear workplaces.

Environmental Impact and Waste Management Strategies - Technical discussion of environmental issues, policy and industry strategies to address tritium, mining and long-term storage.

Tuesday Workshop 1

Managing Change Within Your Chapter - This workshop will discuss issues such as handling the transition that comes with chapter lead turnover and keeping the membership interested when an economic crunch impacts chapter funding.

Creating a Chapter/Fleet and Mixed Membership NA-YGN Budget - This is a practical exercise to help set yearly goals and organize chapter expenses into a budget that will get management's attention and secure funding for activities and events.

Conference Attendance Justification and Reporting - This session will help attendees draft a trip report that highlights the benefits obtained attending similar conferences in a professional manner to validate registration and travel costs.

Reach Out and Connect With Other Chapters - This workshop is designed to give ideas to create opportunities for inter-chapter activities and the benefits of doing such.

Tuesday Workshop 2
